We recognize that the environment in this pandemic remains fluid and our fall plans may change. Please continue to review the website for updates.

Health and safety for everyone remains at the forefront of Coppin's plans for the fall semester. Subsequently, we will offer University Day as a virtual activity on August 17, 2020 where President Jenkins will address the campus community. The Faculty Senate Virtual Retreat is scheduled for August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
